Dear Guang Chen,

According to Florida Statutes, Section 1008.31, and Rule 6A-1.0391, Supplemental Educational Services (SES) providers must submit to the Florida Department of Education (FDOE), by May 1st, student learning gains, student attendance and completion data, and parent, principal, and Local Educational Agency (LEA) satisfaction survey results. The FDOE posted a uniform survey on its website for parents, principals, and LEAs to access and submit electronically to the FDOE.

The FDOE evaluated each SES provider using the information received from SES providers via the online data reporting system. SES providers that served ten or fewer students during the 2011-2012 school year did not receive a service designation, based on accepted professional practices for statistical reliability and the prevention of the unlawful release of personally identifiable student information.

Based on the aggregate data submitted to the FDOE by each SES provider, a service designation of excellent, satisfactory, or unsatisfactory has been assigned for the 2011-2012 school year. You may wish to review the enclosed documentation, which includes your service designation, as well as the aggregate data that was received and used to calculate the designation.

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If you wish to submit a grievance, it must be received by the FDOE no later than 10 days after the FDOE mails official notification and must contain a statement of specific facts the grievant contends warrants reversal or modification of the Department's action and a statement of the specific rules or statutes that the grievant contends requires reversal or modification of the Department's action. A grievance that requests reconsideration without identifying the specific facts that warrant reversal or modification or that fails to include the specific rules or statutes that require reversal or modification will not be considered.
